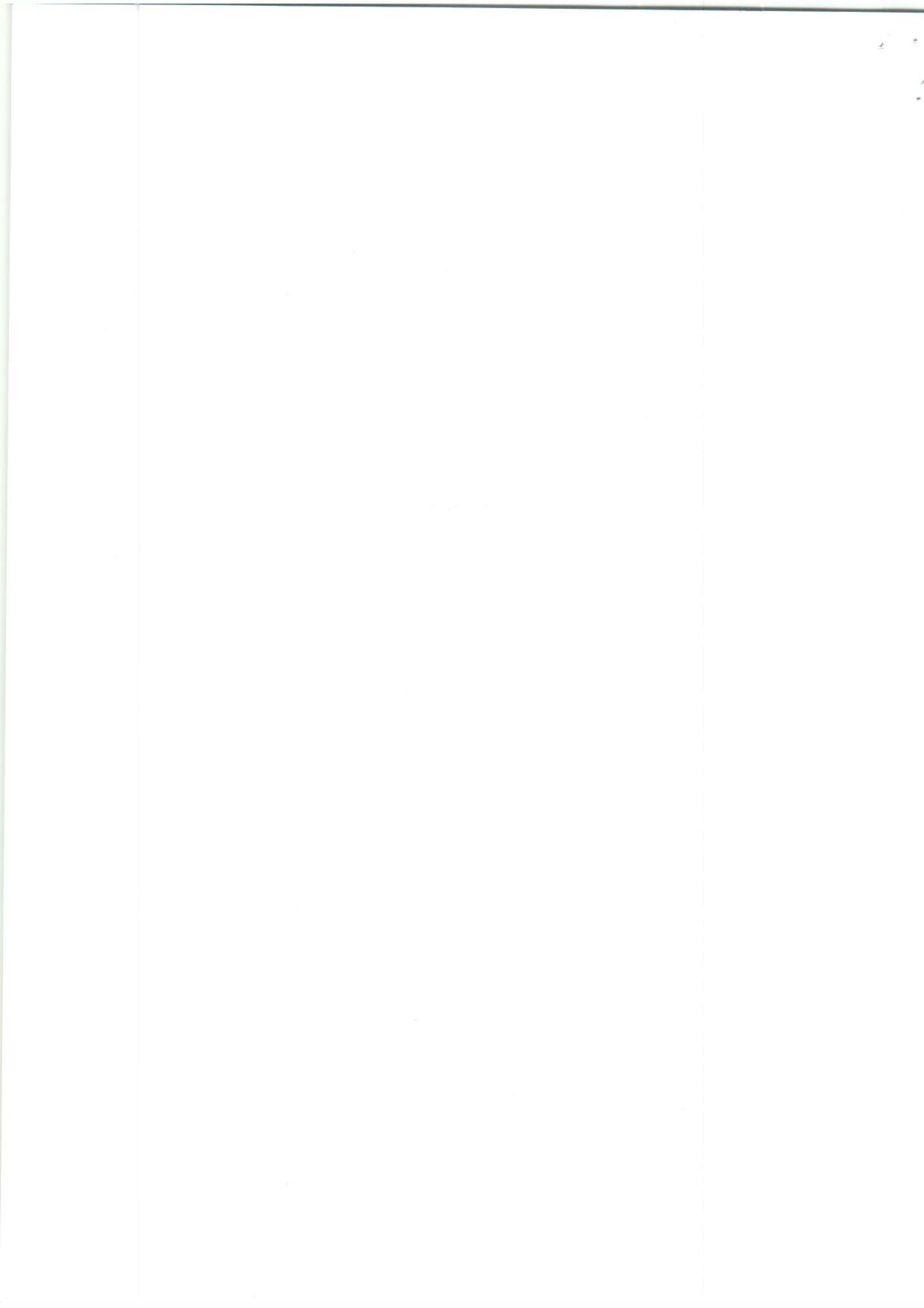

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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

In vetting nominees to the position of the County Chief Officer for the Lands, Physical Planning and Urban Development portfolio, the Committee was guided by Section 8(2) of the Embu County Public Appointment (County Assembly Approval) Act, 2015 and Section 45 of the County Government Act, 2012, among other applicable legal framework.

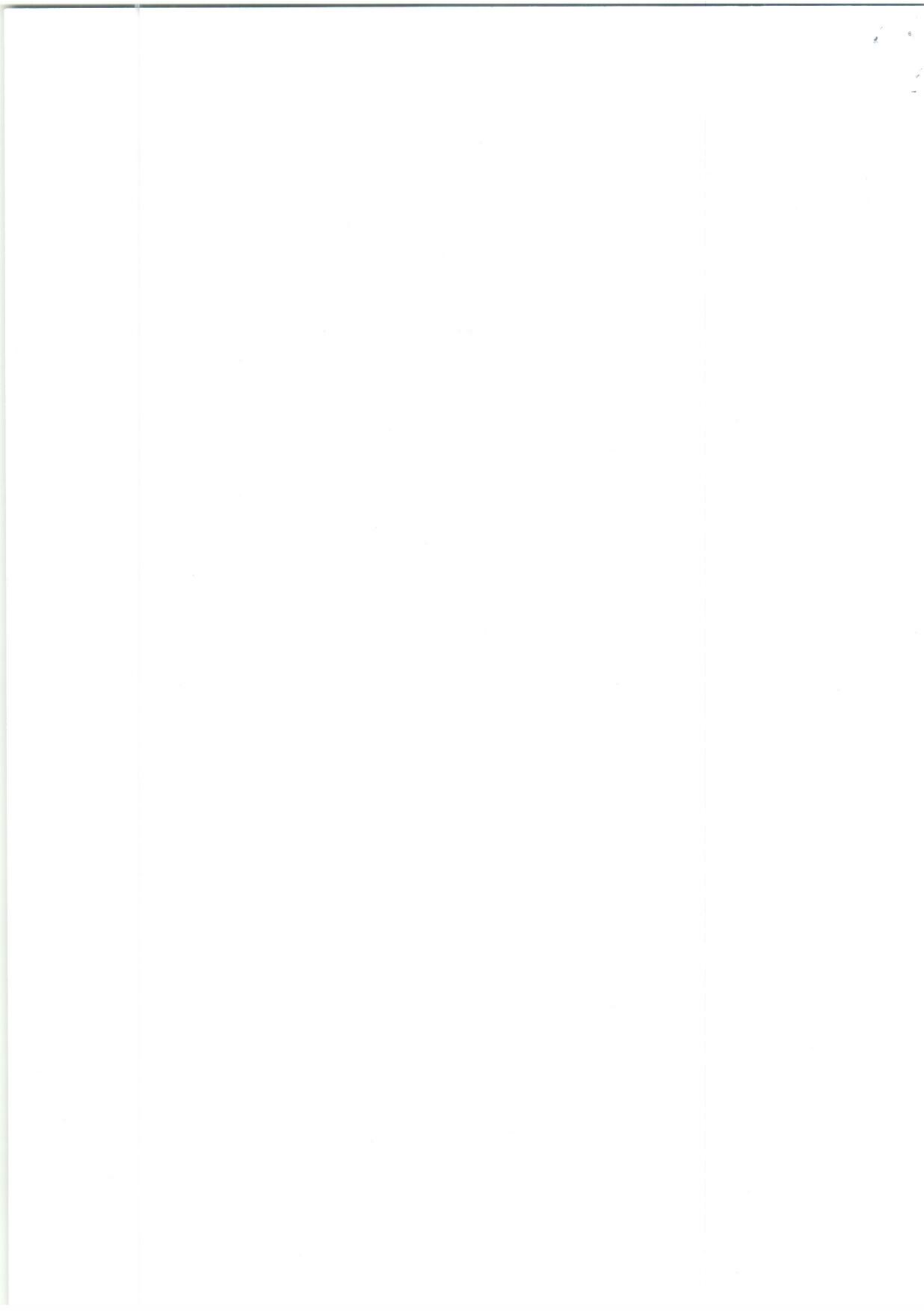
Pursuant to section 45 of the County Government Act, the Governor forwarded the names of various nominees for positions of County Chief Officers including Ms. Mary Ann Ruguru Mwaniki for the Lands, Physical Planning and Urban Development portfolio. The names were submitted to the County Assembly on 27th November 2017 for consideration and vetting by the various sectoral committees..

Pursuant to sections 7 and 8 of the Public Appointments (County Assembly Approval) Act, 2015, the committee successfully conducted the vetting publicly on Thursday 7th November, 2017, where members of public had also been given a chance to interrogate the nominee.

1.0.1 Mandate of the Committee

The Lands, Physical Planning and Urban Development Committee was formed pursuant to Standing Order Number 204(5) of the County Assembly of Embu Standing Orders which provides the functions of a sectoral committee as;

- (a) investigate, inquire into, and report on all matters relating to the mandate, management, activities, administration, operations and estimates of the assigned departments;
- (b) study the programme and policy objectives of departments and the effectiveness of the implementation;
- (c) study and review all County legislation referred to it;
- (d) study, assess and analyse the relative success of the departments as measured by the results obtained as compared with their stated objectives;
- (e) investigate and inquire into all matters relating to the assigned departments as they may deem necessary, and as may be referred to them by the County Assembly;
- (f) to vet and report on all appointments where the Constitution or any law requires the County Assembly to approve, except those under Standing Order 198 (*Committee on Appointments*); and
- (g) make reports and recommendations to the County Assembly as often as possible, including recommendations of proposed legislation.

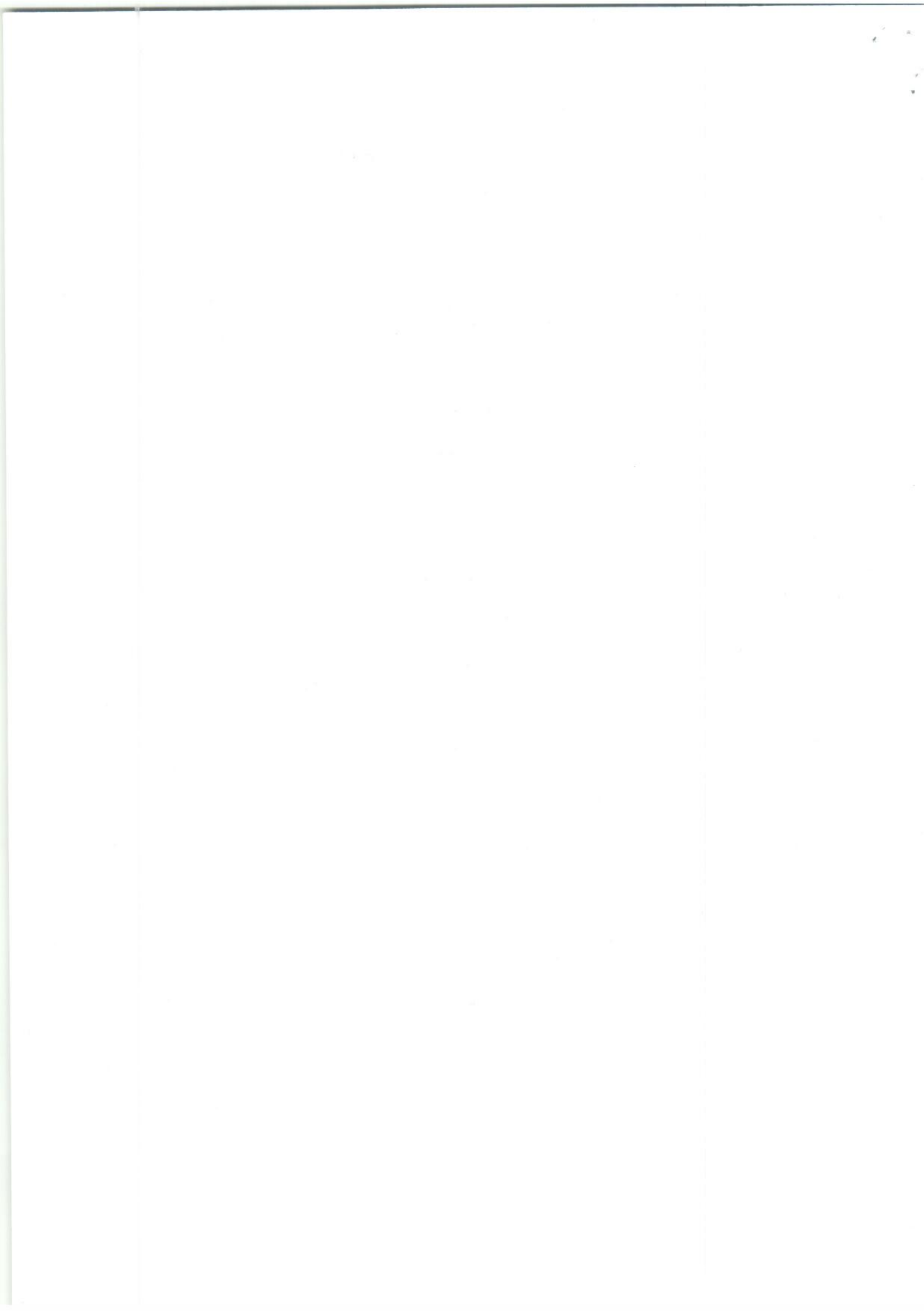

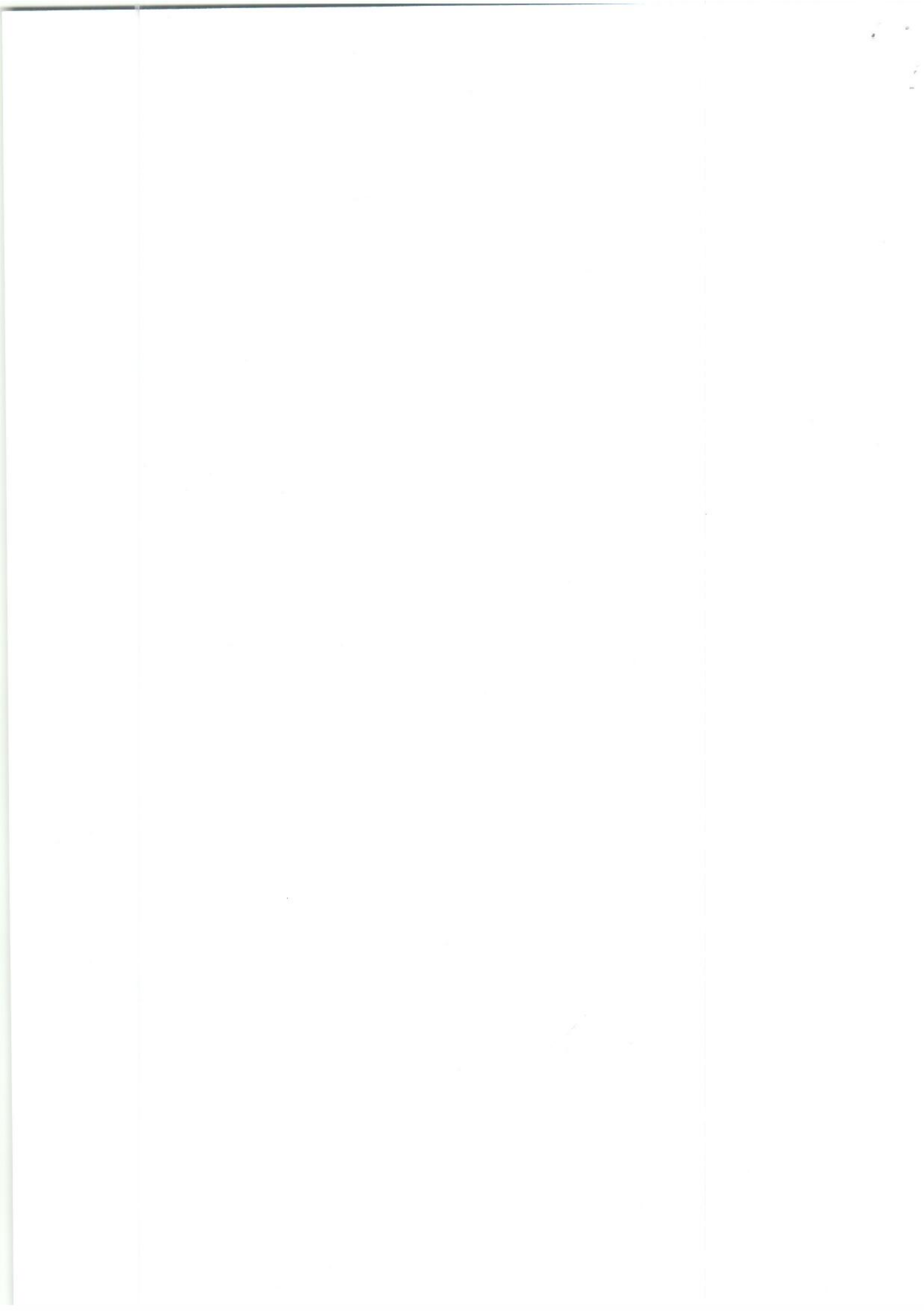

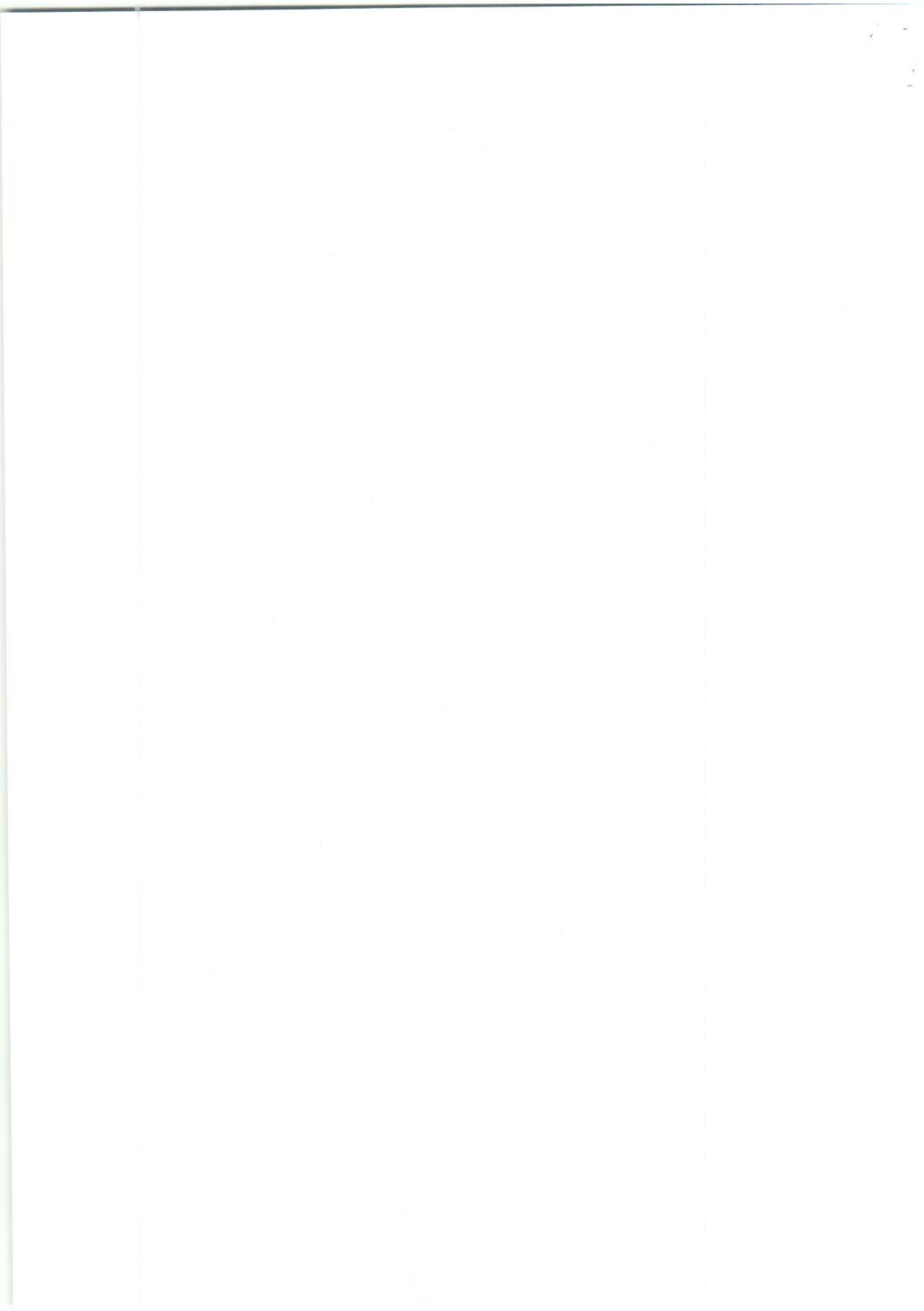


VETTING OF THE NOMINEE.

The Committee, in the course of discharging its mandate of conducting the vetting process, the County Chief Officer nominee was examined against the vetting criteria in accordance with the County Public Appointments (County Assembly Approval) Act, 2015.

- (i) Academic credentials
- (ii) Professional training
- (iii) Experience
- (iv) Personal integrity
- (v) Background
- (vi) Compliance with statutory obligation (EACC clearance, HELB, Certificate of good conduct, CRB and Tax)

The Committee vetted the nominee on Thursday 7th November, 2017.



2.1 COMMITTEE DELIBERATIONS

2.1.0 Functions of a County Chief Officer

The committee noted that in order to carry out an effective vetting exercise it was necessary for members to acquaint themselves with the functions of a County Chief Officers to enable them match the nominees against the functions to be performed and the requirements of the position. Members observed that as per Section 45 (1) of the CGA the County Chief officers shall—

1. Be responsible to the respective county executive committee member for the administration of a county department as provided under section 45.
2. The county chief officer shall be the authorized officer in respect of exercise of delegated power.

2.1.1 Appointment Process of a County Chief Officer

- (i) Pursuant to Section 45(1) of the County Government Act, 2012 and Section 7 of the Embu County Public Appointment (County Assembly Approval) Act of 2015, H.E the Governor, in a letter dated 27th November 2017 Ref No. EBU/C.GVT/GVNR/CAE/1(30) notified the County Assembly through the Clerk the nomination of the candidate for the position of the County Chief Officer – Lands, Physical Planning and Urban Development (iii) On Wednesday 29th November 2017, the Honorable Speaker in a Message to the Assembly, informed the Assembly that the County Assembly had received the names of the candidates nominated for the position of the County Chief Officers. He directed that the names and Curriculum Vitae of the said nominees be referred to the relevant Committee (*The committee on Lands, Physical Planning and Urban Development*) for vetting and reporting to the House within 14 days.
- (iv) The committee was satisfied that the County Assembly complied with provisions of Article 179(2) (b) of the COK as read together with Sections 45 of the CGA, 2012 of the Embu County Public Appointment (County Assembly Approval) Act, 2015 on the notification to the nominees and to the public to submit memorandum in respect of the nominees, which notification was made through an advertisement in the media on 30th November 2017.

However no memorandum was received from the members of the public.



2.2 CRITERIA FOR VETTING AND APPROVAL FOR MS. MARYANN RUGURU MWANIKI NOMINEE FOR COUNTY CHIEF OFFICER, LANDS PHYSICAL PLANNING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT.

Based the above legal framework the committee relied on the following criteria on vetting and approval of the nominee

1. Completion of the questionnaire.

It was observed that the nominee had fully filled the questionnaire .

2. A minimum of a degree from a recognized university

It was observed that the nominee had a Bachelors Degree in Arts and two Masters Degrees-one in Planning and the other in Urban Management and Development. (See Annexure II)

3.Understanding of the position to which the candidate is proposed for appointment

From the submissions the candidates understood the position she was nominated for.

4.Experience relevant to the position five years experience in administration

The candidate had the relevant experience

5.Clearance from Ethics and Anti-Corruption Commission (EACC), Higher Education Loans Board (HELB), Kenya Police Service (Certificate of Good Conduct),and Kenya Revenue Authority (KRA)

All the above clearances were submitted.

6.Willingness to work for the prescribed remuneration

The nominee was ready to work for the prescribed remuneration.

7.Knowledge of government management systems related to being a County Chief Officer.

From the submissions, the nominee understood the government management systems.

8. Understanding of relationship with County Executive Committee

From the submissions, the nominee understood the above relationship.
