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THE EMBU COUNTY FINANCE BILL, 2025

A Bill for

AN ACT of the County Assembly of Embu to amend the law relating to various fees, taxes and charges for services, and other revenue raising measures by the County Government; and for matters incidental thereto

ENACTED by the County Assembly of Embu, as follows—

PART I — PRELIMINARY

Short title and commencement

1. This Act may be cited as the Embu County Finance Act, 2025 and shall come into operation upon publication in the *Gazette*.

PART II— TAXES, FEES AND CHARGES PAYABLE AND RATES APPLICATION

Annual fees

2. The taxes, fees, charges, levies, cess and penalties set out in the charges column shall apply for the respective items listed in the activity codes and at the rates set in the Schedules.

Fees due and payable

- 3. Despite the generality of Section 2—
- (a) fees and penalties that remain outstanding at the commencement of this Act shall remain due and payable to the County Revenue Account.
- (b) annual licenses and permits including promotions and adverts shall lapse on the 31st day of December in each year,
 - Provided that any business commencing after the month of June shall pay annual business permit fees equivalent to half of the annual business permit fees applicable in the First Schedule.
- (c) a penalty of 5% of the applicable annual fees shall apply for every month in which the fees remain unpaid after 31st of March in each Year.

Business Licenses or permits

4. (1) A person shall not carry out any business or service within the County without a valid license, permit or receipt of such other fees issued in accordance with this Act or any other applicable county legislation.

- (2) A person who intends to carry out any of the businesses listed in the or under the schedule or the single business permit regulation, shall apply for a license or permit from any of the County offices or such other designated agents as shall be prescribed by the County Government from time to time.
- (3) A person who applies for license under subsection (2) will be issued with a license on the payment of the applicable fee as specified in the third, fourth, fifth, sixth and seventh columns in respect of the business activities defined in the first and second columns of the First Schedule depending on the location and size of the business as specified in the schedules of the single business permit Fees and Charges.
- (4) Notwithstanding the provision of sub-clause (3), no business permit shall be issued to a person intending to operate a business dealing in alcoholic drinks as defined in the county legislation on alcoholic drinks control, if the proposed location of the business is not in an urban centre, town, commercial centre, shopping center, or a market place within Embu County.
- (5) Licenses and permits issued under subsection (3) must be visibly displayed at the business premise at all times. Failure to display license or produce on demand amounts to an offence.
- (6) A person who contravenes any of the provisions of this section commits an offence.

Rents and Rates

- 5. (1) A person occupying any plot, stall or house leased or rented out by the County Government shall pay rent in advance at the rate specified in the Second Schedule to this Act.
- (2) For any rent payable under sub section (1) that remain unpaid after the 5th of the subsequent month shall attract a penalty of (3%) three per centum per month.
- (3) A person who contravenes the provisions of Sub sections (1) may be evicted upon issuance of notice as per any written law.
- (4) There shall be charged interest at the rate of two per centum (2%) per month and a penalty of 3% per month for any ground rent payable annually with effect from 1st of April for each year until the payment is made in full.
- (5) For ratable properties the annual rates shall be zero point five per centum (0.5 %) of the current value of the property as per the existing valuation Roll.

- (6) There shall be charged interest at the rate of two per centum (2%) per month and a penalty of three per centum 3% per month for any rates payable annually under sub-section (5) with effect from 1st of April for each year until the payment is made in full.
- (7) The County Government may repossess the plot if a person fails to pay the ground rent for more than one year and five years for land rates.

Penalties for defaulters

- 6. (1) A person or entity that defaults on payment of any fees shall have committed an offence punishable—
 - (a) in the case of business permits, by a fine not exceeding One hundred thousand in addition to the payment or six months imprisonment or both notwithstanding interest accrued on late payments;
 - (b) in the case of market charges and Business permits, by impounding of commodities and holding the same in safe custody until fees and impounding charges are paid;
 - (c) All goods will be impounded at owner's risk.
 - (i) For perishable goods they must be collected before close of business the next day after the impounding day.
 - (ii) Livestock impounded must be collected within two working days.
 - (iii) For any other goods and tools, they must be collected within fourteen days.
 - (iv) The County will dispose of all goods and livestock after the prescribed period expires in a manner it deems fit;
 - (d) in the case of advertisements, promotions and any outdoor publicity, by a fine equal to three times the applicable fees;
 - (e) in the case of all fees related to buildings and constructions approvals, by a fine equal to three times the applicable fees.

MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

The Bill is intended to provide for various taxation mechanisms, imposition of fees and charges for services, and other revenue raising measures by the County Government; and for matters incidental thereto. It has two parts and ten schedules.

Part I—Preliminary—The part contains the short title of the Act.

Part II—Taxes, Fees and Charges Payable and Rates Applicable (2-6)

— The part defines various taxes that can be imposed by the County Government, fees and charges payable for various goods and services. It provides for rent and rates applicable, duty to pay allocated fee, categorization of commercial centers with different rates applicable.

Part III— this part is on amendments to The Embu County Trade Promotion, Development and Licensing Act, 2023 it makes amendments to the fourth schedule and seeks to add new schedule to the same Act.

Part IV— this part is on amendments to The Embu County Tourism Act 2018 by adding a new schedule to the Act.

Part V— this part is on amendments to the Embu County Vocational Training Centres Act, 2015 by adding a new schedule to the Act.

Part VI— this part is on amendments to the Embu County Childcare Facilities Act, 2016 by adding a new schedule to the Act.

Part VII— this part is on amendments to the Embu County Early Childhood Development and Education Act, 2015 by adding a new schedule to the Act.

Part VIII— this part is on amendments to the Embu County Laws, Compliance and Enforcement Act, 2024 by adding a new schedule to the Act.

Part IX— this part is on amendments to the Embu County Environment Management Act, 2015 by adding a new schedule to the Act.

Part X— this part is on amendments to the Embu County Water Act, 2016 by adding a new schedule to the Act.

Part XI— this part is on amendments to the Embu County Cultural Heritage Act, 2016 by adding a new schedule to the Act.
