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1.0. BACKGROUND

In vetting nominees to the positions of the County chief officers under the portfolio on Agriculture, Livestock, Fisheries and Cooperatives, the Committee was guided by section 8(2) of the Embu County Public Appointment (County Assembly Approval) Act, 2015 and Section 45 of County Government Act, 2012, among other applicable legal framework.

Pursuant to Section 45 of the County Governments Act, 2012, the names of the nominees for the County Chief Officers including the names of Mrs. Mary Mercy Wanja Munene for Agriculture and Cooperatives, and Alvan Mugendi Gatumu for Livestock and Fisheries were submitted to the County Assembly on 27th November, 2017 for vetting and approval. The names of the nominees were tabled on 29th December, 2017 and subsequently committed to the committee on Agriculture, Livestock, Fisheries and Cooperatives for consideration.

The committee conducted the vetting and approval hearing on 7th December, 2017 in the Embu County committee rooms in Ghyanshyam plaza, and retreated to compile this report for consideration by the Assembly. This was in line with the Embu County Public Appointment (County Assembly Approval) Act, 2015.

1.0.1. Mandate of the Committee

The Committee on Agriculture, Livestock, Fisheries and Cooperatives has made this report pursuant to Standing Order No. 204 (5) of the County Assembly of Embu which states that; The functions of a Sectoral Committee shall be to-

- a) investigate, inquire into, and report on all matters relating to the mandate, management, activities, administration, operations and estimates of the assigned departments;
- b) study the programme and policy objectives of departments and the effectiveness of the implementation;
- c) study and review all County legislation referred to it;
- d) study, assess and analyse the relative success of the departments as measured by the results obtained as compared with their stated objectives;
- e) investigate and inquire into all matters relating to the assigned departments as they may deem necessary, and as may be referred to them by the County Assembly;
- f) to vet and report on all appointments where the Constitution or any law requires the County Assembly to approve, except those under Standing Order 198 (*Committee on Appointments*); and
- g) make reports and recommendations to the County Assembly as often as possible, including recommendation of proposed legislation.

1.1. PROBLEM STATEMENT

This report is compiled in fulfillment of provisions in the County Governments Act, 2012 and the Embu County Public Appointment (County Assembly Approval) Act, 2015 that gives guidelines on the process of vetting and approval of public appointments.

Based on the aforementioned background, the committee conducted vetting and approval hearing exercise for the nominees for the positions of the County Chief Officer in charge of Agriculture and Cooperatives, Mrs. Mary Mercy Wanjia Munene and the County Chief Officer in charge of Livestock and Fisheries, Mr. Alvan Mugendi Gatumu.

1.2. TERMS OF REFERENCE

1. To consider and vet the nominee for the position of County Chief Officer, Agriculture and Cooperatives: Mrs. Mary Mercy Wanjia Munene.
2. To consider and vet the nominee for the position of County Chief Officer, Livestock and Fisheries: Mr. Alvan Mugendi Gatumu respectively.
3. To make relevant recommendations on the nominees for consideration and adoption by the County Assembly.

1.3. METHODOLOGY

The committee applied the following methods to come up with this report;

1. Committee meetings
2. Conducting vetting exercise publicly in committee rooms
3. Perusing and analyzing testimonials and other documents of the nominees; and
4. Receiving and considering oral views and written submission from the nominees

Finally the committee acknowledges the nominees for their presentations and cooperation throughout the exercise and members of public during the vetting and approval hearing exercise.

It is therefore my pleasant duty and privilege, on behalf of the Committee on Agriculture, Livestock, Fisheries and Cooperatives to table this report and recommend its adoption by the Assembly

2.0. COMMITTEE FINDINGS AND OBSERVATIONS

2.1 GUIDING LEGAL FRAMEWORK

(a) Embu County Public Appointment (County Assembly Approval) Act, 2015

In the vetting and approval process, the committee was guided by Section 8 of the Embu County Public Appointment (County Assembly Approval) Act, 2015 which provides that:-

"8 (1) Upon receipt of notification of nomination, the Clerk shall cause a notification to be made to the Assembly upon which it shall stand committed to the relevant Sectoral Committee.

(2) Upon receipt of a notification under subsection (1) the committee shall determine the time and place for the holding of the approval hearing.

3) The Clerk shall notify a candidate of the time and place for the holding of an approval hearing and the committee shall-

(a) notify the public of the time and place for holding an approval hearing at least seven days prior to the hearing; and

(b) make the notice referred to under subsection (3)(a) above using modalities applicable under section 91 of the County Governments Act, 2012.

(4) The committee shall vet the respective candidate by way of scrutinizing the information provided by the appointing Authority and holding an approval hearing in accordance with this Act and the County Assembly Standing Orders.

(5) An approval hearing shall focus on a candidate's academic credentials, professional training and experience, personal integrity and background and any other matter that the committee may deem relevant."

(2) Other Legal Framework

The committee was also guided by the following legal framework:

1. Article 226 (2) of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010
2. Section 45 an of the County Government Act, 2012
3. Section 149 of Public Finance Management Act, 2012 as read together with Regulation 22 of the Public Finance Management (County Governments) Regulations, 2015.
4. Section 8 and 9 of Embu County Public Appointment (County Assembly Approval) Act 2015; and

5. Standing order No. 2014 (5) (i) of the County Assembly of Embu Standing Orders.
